3. In your opinion, which situation will most frequently lead to an error in the case of a poorly designed interface?

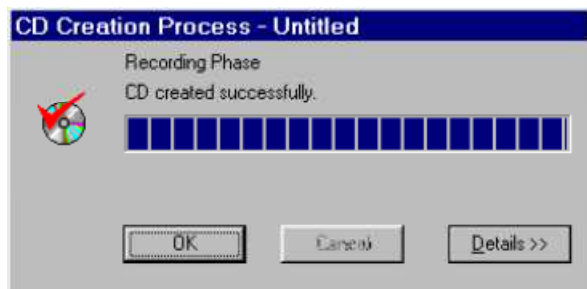

II. Consider the two messages below, obtained in two different situations at the end of the operation. Critique these two designs and justify your answer.

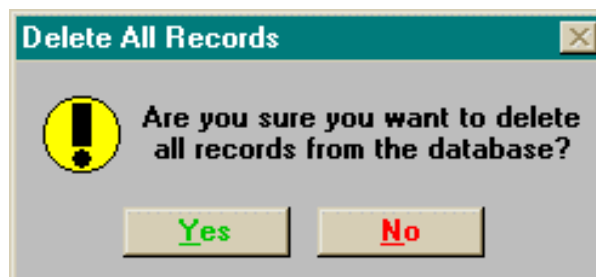

Figure 1. Google advanced search

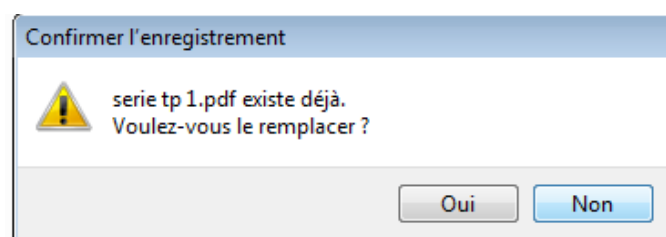


Figure 2 . Confirmation of registration

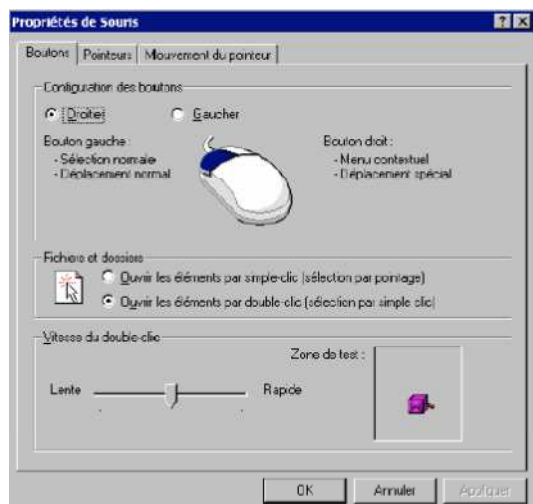


Figure 3. Mouse Properties

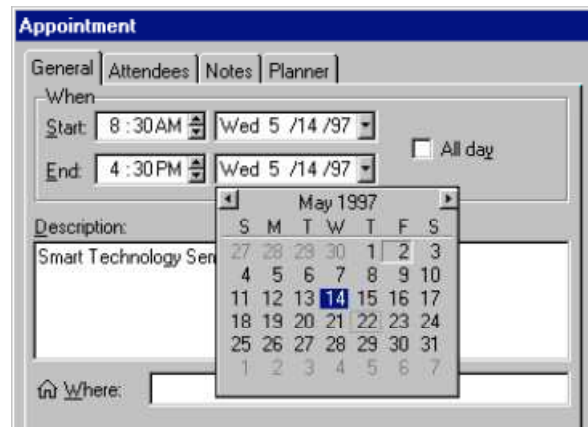


Figure 4. Calendar



Figure 5. Start Menu Taskbar Properties

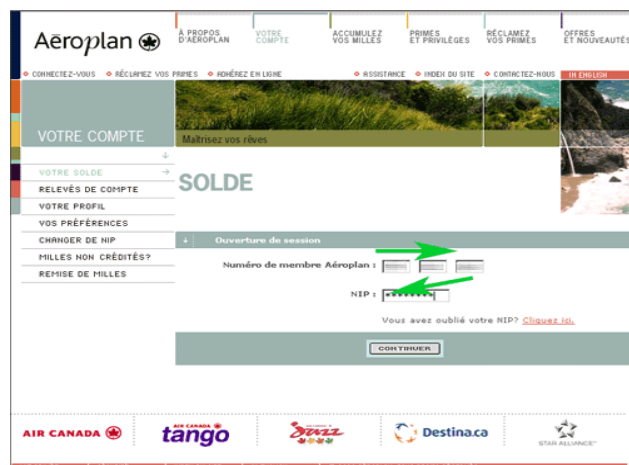


Figure 6. Web site

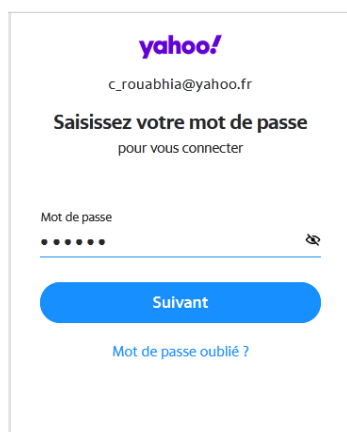


Figure 7. Authentification, Yahoo

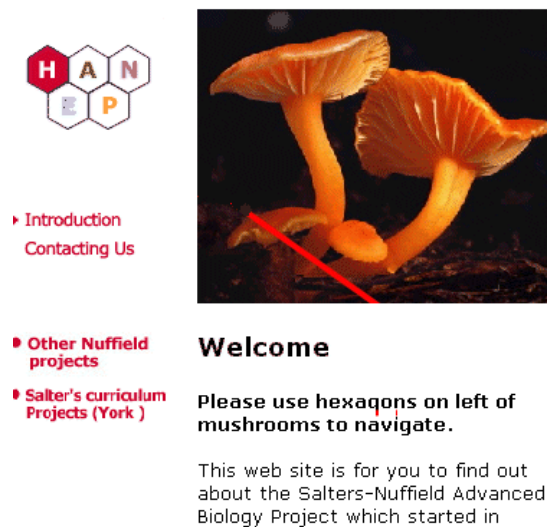

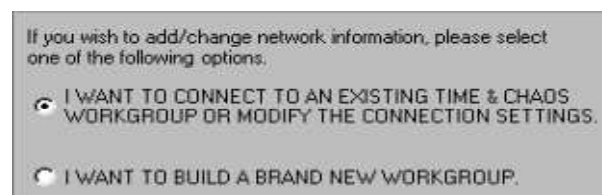
